Good to Know

Internship	Internships are part of the curriculum and mandatory for graduation. Depending on the student 's year and major the requirements are different. Our students will be able to share these conditions with you during a video call.
Graduation Project/ Bachelor project	This is a collaboration between a student and a company, with a strategic goal and added value to the company. The project is not part of the day-to-day operations. The student will make an analysis, provide advice and an implementation plan.
Accommodation	The student will look for a place to stay but help is always welcome.
